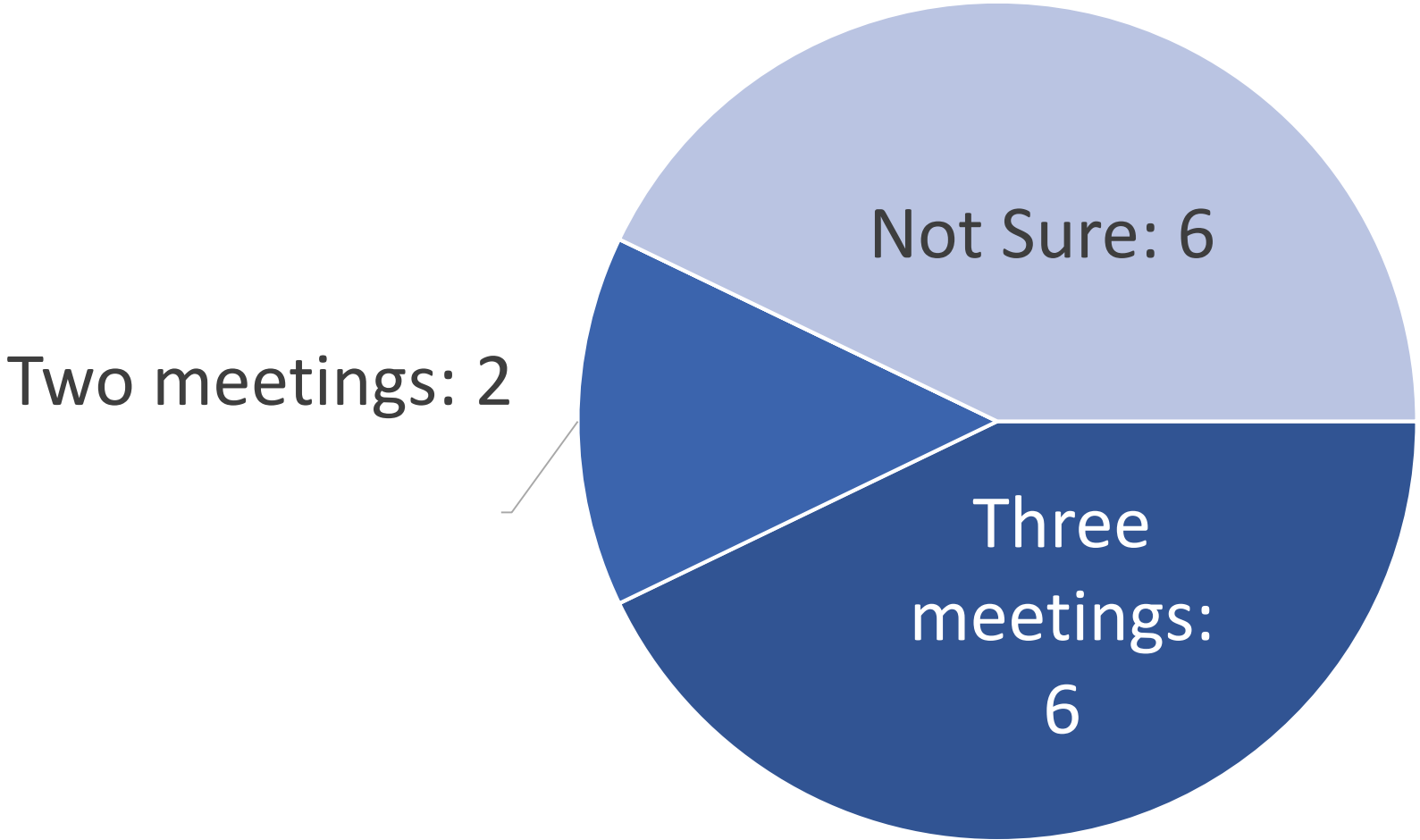

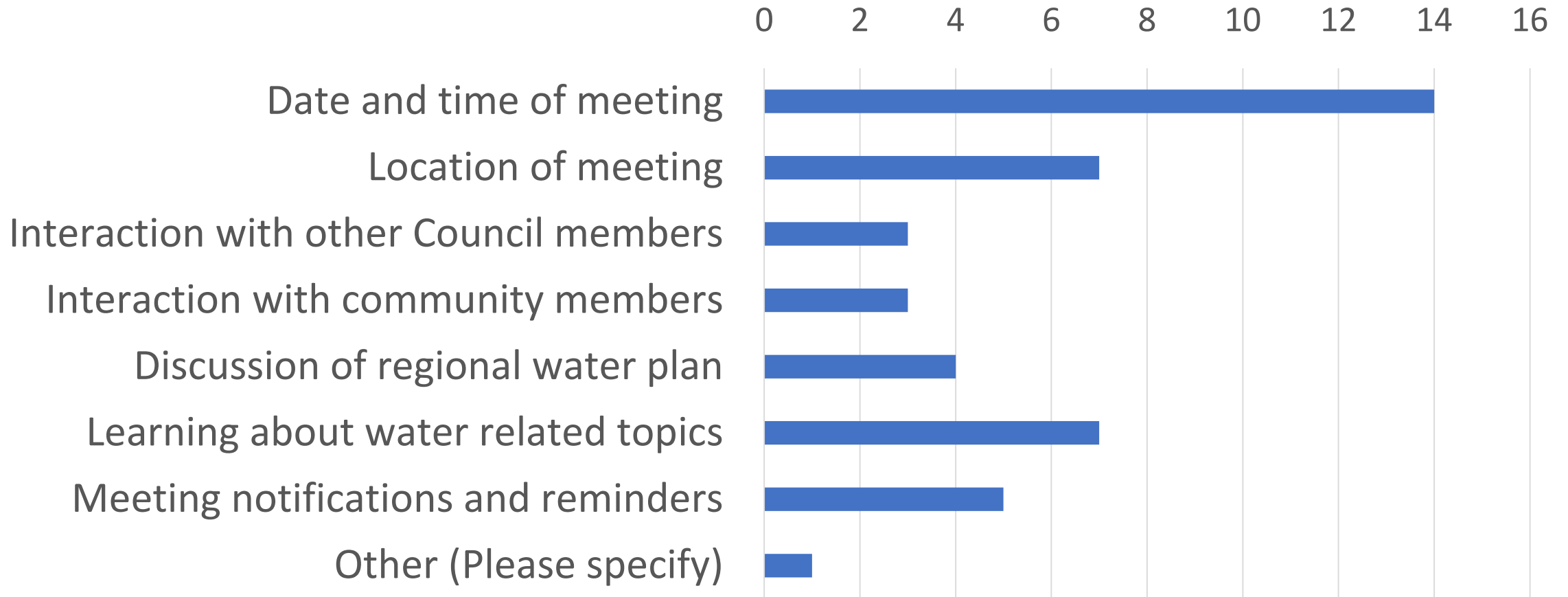


**How many Lower Flint-Ochlockonee Regional Water Council meetings have you attended so far in 2018 & 2019?**
