

FY23 RWP Seed Grant Program

- Funding for projects that implement Regional Water Plan management practices/recommendations
- Letter of endorsement from Council Chair
- Up to \$75,000 state funding available (per project)
- Cost-Share: 60% state /40% match (with at least 10% cash match)
- Grant Announcement will go out in July
- Pre-application meeting & application deadlines in October

The State Water Plan ensures Georgia's water resources are sustainably managed through at least 2050. The Regional Water Plans set forth the recommended management practices for each water planning region.

EPD is extending the Plan Updates process

- Current timeline for the Plan Updates process is:
 - Draft Updated Plans completed by end of September
 - Public Notice period (45 days)
 - Final Updated Plans approved by December
- Based on delays in presenting technical information to the Councils (including time spent factoring Metro District forecasts into future condition modeling), EPD is adding another 6 months to the Plan Updates process
 - Final Updated Plans to be approved by June 2023
 - Continue to hold quarterly Council meetings
- Does not impact coordination with, or future planning cycles being coordinated with, the Metro District
