Parking Information for the Phinizy Center

From Lock & Dam Road, turn left onto the Phinizy Center driveway at the “Phinizy Swamp Nature Park” sign (look for the dragonfly).

If you arrive late or you want to take a nice nature walk:

- From Lock & Dam Road, proceed about 300 ft on the Phinizy Center driveway and watch for the “Phinizy Swamp Campus” sign on your right.
- There will be a large parking area on your left.
- You can take the sidewalk along the driveway to the campus (green buildings on left), or there is a pedestrian boardwalk through the swamp to the Phinizy Center. You will find the boardwalk entrance at the back of the parking lot, to the right of the silos.

Limited early arrival parking and drop-offs:

- Proceed down the driveway to the Phinizy Center campus – green-roof buildings on the left.
- Parking in front is limited, but this is a convenient location for drop-offs.
